

Terms and conditions:

1. THE AWARD OWNER

1.1. This Journal Paper Award is run by Taylor & Francis, a trading division of Informa UK Limited, a company registered in England and Wales with company number 01072954 whose registered address is at 5 Howick Place, London SW1P 1WG (the “**Award Owner**”).

2. THE AWARD

2.1. The title of the award is the **Sessler Early Career Researcher Prize**. The inaugural award was made in 2018.

2.2. The Editors of “*Supramolecular Chemistry*” (the “**Journal**”) are awarding the Sessler Early Career Researcher Prize of \$1000 USD (the “**Award**”) to a talented, early career Principal Investigator/researcher who is within 12 years of receiving their PhD degree on the date of submission of their manuscript. The winner is an author who is judged to have made a significant contribution to a top-quality paper that has been published in the Journal the previous year (the “**Winner**”).

2.3. Conditional on the agreement of the conference organizers, winning authors will be invited to present their work at the International Symposium of Macrocyclic and Supramolecular Chemistry (ISMSC) in the following year [note: neither the ISMSC or Taylor & Francis will contribute to any costs incurred in accepting the invitation to present]. The ability to take up the invitation to present the work at the following International Symposium of Macrocyclic and Supramolecular Chemistry (ISMSC) will not affect the selection of the winner of the “**Award**”.

3. PROCEDURE

3.1. The award is available to all papers published within the annual journal volume and in an issue (excluding latest articles) for the period 1 January through to 31 December inclusive.

3.2. Nomination will be via email: supramolecular@tulane.edu and must be received by 31 January in the subsequent year. Candidates will be required to submit a CV and cover letter stating which article the author wishes to nominate and why they think it is eligible. Winning authors will be invited to give a talk at the International Symposium of Macrocyclic and Supramolecular Chemistry (ISMSC) ISMSC in the following year. In your application, please confirm your availability to speak at the conference.

3.3. The Award Owner will **not** accept:

3.3.1. Responsibility for nominations that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.

3.3.2. Responsibility for the agreement between the journal editors and the organizers of the relevant ISMSC meeting for winning authors to present their work at said meeting.

3.3.3. Proof of transmission as proof of receipt of nomination.

3.4. By submitting a nomination, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions and any relevant terms found on the journal website.

3.5. For help with entries, please contact the Editor at supramolecular@tulane.edu.

3.6. The nominations will be judged by three advisory board members of the Journal (“**Judges**”) appointed by the Editors. The decision of the Judges (acting reasonably) will be final.

3.7. The Award Owner will send the full names of the judges to anyone who writes within one month after the Closing Date of the competition requesting details of the judges and who encloses a self-addressed envelope to the address set out in clause 1.1.

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1. In order to be eligible to participate in the competition, the nominees must:

4.1.1. Be an early career Principal Investigator/researcher within 12 years of receiving their PhD degree on the date of submission of their manuscript.



- 4.1.2. Be available to present their research at the next year's ISMSC conference
- 4.1.3. Not be an employee of Taylor & Francis, its subsidiary and holding companies, their agents or any other person who is directly connected with the creation and operation of the competition or their immediate family; and
- 4.1.4. Not be located in a sanctioned or embargoed country according to the International Trade Sanctions, as updated from time to time.
- 4.2. In entering the award, all entrants must be eligible to do so and that the winner is eligible to claim the prize. The Award Owner may require proof that the nominations are eligible to enter the award.
- 4.3. The Award Owner is not obliged to accept nominations that are incomplete.
- 4.4. The Award Owner reserves all rights to refuse nominations if any conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the award.

5. THE AWARD

- 5.1. The award is **\$1,000 USD** (one thousand United States Dollars).
- 5.2. The award is not negotiable or transferable.
- 5.3. The winner will be contacted by the Editor once the winner has been selected and agreed using the email address provided on the entry.
- 5.4. In order to receive the award, the winner must respond to the Editors email and consent the Taylor & Francis using their name, image and institutional affiliation to announce the winner of this award and for any other reasonable and related promotional purposes.
- 5.5. Taylor & Francis and the Editor will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner.
- 5.6. Taylor & Francis does not accept any responsibility if the winner elects not to accept the award.

6. WINNER ANNOUNCEMENT

- 6.1. The name and institutional affiliation or country of the winner can be viewed on the Journal News and Sessler Award website 14 days after the winner has been announced.
- 6.2. The decision of the Editor and Judges is final, and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- 7.1. Insofar as is permitted by law, neither the Award Owner, nor its parent, subsidiary, affiliated and/or related companies, nor any of its or their shareholders, directors, officers, agents, employees, contractors or distributors shall in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the entrant or winner, or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of being entered into the award process or accepting the award. Nothing in these terms and conditions shall exclude or restrict the Award Owner's liability for death or injury resulting from the negligence of the Award Owner, or fraud and/or fraudulent misrepresentation. Your statutory rights are not affected.

8. DATA PROTECTION AND PUBLICITY

- 8.1. The winner of the award must consent to Taylor & Francis using their name, image and institutional affiliation or country of residence to announce the winner of the award and for any other reasonable and related promotional purposes.
- 8.2. By entering this award, the authors agree that any personal information provided to this award may be held and used only by the Award Owner and its affiliates to administer the award.

9. GENERAL

- 9.1. If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the Award Owner may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude any nominations from the award.
- 9.2. The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the journal article award should it becomes necessary to do so.

- 9.3. Participants acknowledge and agree that in entering this journal award, they will comply with all applicable laws and regulations including, without limitation, the Bribery Act 2010.
- 9.4. These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
