## ► Read and Publish

- Tailored Read and Publish agreements remove author APCs, promoting research accessibility.
- Partnerships enable libraries to manage resources effectively, retaining access to subscription content.
- Enjoy dedicated customer service, prioritizing your institution's requirements throughout the partnership.

## ► OA Journal Memberships

- Institutional membership establishes a fund with T&F for authors to publish in gold OA journals.
- Renewable and flexible funds ensure ongoing support for open research.
- Membership options: Taylor & Francis/Routledge, F1000/Routledge Open Research, and Dove Journals.

## ► OA Book Memberships

- OA book memberships offer a secure prepayment account, book content discounts, and simplify BPC (Book Processing Charge) funding.
- Memberships offer streamlined administration and personalized support and ensure compliance with funder and institutional mandates.

## ► Pledge to Open

- Collective funding pilot: 70 OA books on global issues like climate change, mental health, women's rights, and race.
- Institutions can support themed collections of 10 frontlist research books.
- Upon reaching funding goals, books become freely accessible online for global collaboration.
